1 st 2nd or 3 shot . South CURB, MAIN ST

2 or 3rd SHOT . KENNEDY'S HEAD

CONNALLY'S BACK,

1. Three bullets fired:

- ✓ One through JFK and Connally (7 wounds).
- ✓ One hits JFK in lower back of head, exits top right.
- ✓ One misses (fragment of bullet or curb hits James Tague).
- 2. Oswald fired all three (and only three) shots.
- 3. Oswald also shot officer J.D. Tippit.
- 4. Oswald had no (known) accomplices.


5. Oswald was shot by Jack Ruby on 11/24 in the basement of Dallas Police Headquarters, of his own volition. Oswald and Ruby did not know each other or have common acquaintances.





Warren Commission Conclusions





This is how the Commission diagrammed the two shots into Kennedy, both from behind.

Therefore, with both shots from the rear, President Kennedy should have moved sharply forward in the limousine



The Zapruder Film



Most observers would say that the Zapruder film is a key piece of evidence exonerating Oswald, since it shows Kennedy rocketing backwards in the limo, when in fact Oswald was firing from behind.



Life & the Zapruder Film



Life magazine purchased all rights to the film within 72 hours.

They never showed the film in any public venue.

In fact they lied about what it depicted.

On December 6th, editor Paul Mandel wrote that Kennedy turns in the film back towards the Texas School Book Depository. He was then shot by Oswald in the throat.



Life & the Zapruder Film

Since *Life* had the film, Mandel had to have known this information was false.

At no point does Kennedy turn around back toward the Book Depository to be in a position to be struck by a bullet in the throat.

It's not even a close call.





The Throat Wound





So why did Mandel deceive the public about an important aspect of the JFK case?

- Oswald had been killed on 11/24. He was now the designated fall guy; he himself said he was a "patsy".
- Since no one else had the film, there could be no dispute about what it showed.
- The doctors at Parkland Hospital stated that there was a wound in the front of JFK's throat; Dr Perry had said it was an entrance wound no less than three times on the day of the assassination.

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The Throat Wound Disappears



As Life must have known, since they had the film, no such movement exists. On December 14, Life is still sticking to this story, as can be seen by the caption to frames 1 & 2 above:

Past the book warehouse the President turned to his right to wave to someone (1). Just as his car passed behind the road sign shown in the foreground the first bullet struck him in the neck. He clutched at his throat (2)

Though less clearly articulated here, one has only to read further in the issue to find Mandel's article reprinted under a slightly different title ("First Answers to Nagging Rumors: What Lay Behind Six Crucial Seconds"), but with essentially the same text containing the crucial gloss quoted above. The only way to sustain this ruse was to omit the intermittent frames which would have given the lie to this explanation. The frame with Kennedy waving has purposely been made the focus here; interestingly, it was missing from the black-and-white sequence in the November 29th issue, which shows only three of the frames before the limousine emerges from behind the Stemmons Freeway sign. In just four more days, however, this entire charade will no longer be


What Mandel wrote was to counter the question: How could Kennedy have been hit in the throat from the front when Oswald was behind him?

It remained viable since no one had seen the film yet.

But there were at least three other ways this front throat shot was going to be made to disappear.



The Throat Wound Disappears



First, the Secret Service was going to pick up all films of the Malcolm Perry/Kemp Clark press conference held from about 2:00-3:15 PM in Dallas where Perry said there was a front throat wound and Clark said there was a large gaping wound in the back of Kennedy's skull.

Second, the Secret Service lied to the Warren Commission and attorney Arlen Specter. They said they did not have the transcript of this press conference, yet they did have one.

Why was it important to collect the films and deep six the transcript of the Perry/Clark press conference?

- Perry performed the tracheotomy on Kennedy, and therefore had the best view of the front throat wound.
- Clark was chief of neurosurgery; he would certainly know what a wound to the head looked like.

What both men were saying was that Kennedy was shot from the front. A large gaping hole in the rear of the head denotes an exit wound.



The Parkland Doctors Recant



After Perry concluded his press conference, a well dressed man grabbed him by the arm and told him "Don't ever say that again."

That evening, Perry got calls from the Bethesda morgue where Kennedy's autopsy had been performed.

He said the autopsy doctors wanted him to change his story about the entrance wound from the front.


They threatened to take him before a medical board and strip him of his license.

Warren Commission Hearings VI: 7-18

That was not the end of it.

Secret Service agents Elmer Moore and Roger Warner were stationed at Parkland Hospital and tried to massage the emergency room doctors' testimony to the official autopsy report written by Dr. James Humes.

That report said there were no frontal shots; the only shots came from the rear.

This worked with Perry. For the official federal government inquiry, the Warren Commission, he changed his story. He now said the wound could have been one of exit or entrance.



Secrecy and Censorship

As the viewer can see, there is much being done in the early days of this case through censorship and secret subterfuge in order to alter the forensic facts of the JFK case.

Evidence is being hidden, stolen or lied about. Witnesses are being talked out of their original stories.

If the Kennedy case had been a real trial, abiding by rules of the court, these would all be considered crimes, specifically obstruction of justice and witness intimidation.



Media Complicity

The problem was this: virtually no one knew any of these things were happening. The media was not reporting it. In fact, they were either cooperating with it, were not aware of it, or simply did not report it—even if they knew about it.

The media was thus paving the way for the Warren Commission to work in secret. This would be unimaginable today, since there would be media protests and lawsuits galore.


But the fact the Commission worked in secret made it easier for their report to be accepted in September of 1964. And again, the media was very cooperative in getting it accepted.





The Warren Commission: Origin





After Ruby murdered Oswald on TV, while he was literally in the arms of the Dallas Police, Lyndon Johnson was coaxed into appointing an extraordinary panel to investigate the Kennedy assassination. It was headed by Chief Justice Earl Warren.



LBJ and Earl Warren




LBJ intimidated a reluctant Warren into serving as the chair by telling him that there might be atomic warfare with Moscow and 40 million could be dead within an hour unless he took the helm.


LBJ needed Warren since he was an icon to the liberal community.








Example 1: The Weapon





The rifle in evidence was not the rifle that the Commission said Oswald ordered.

- It is a different length, weight and classification.
- And as anyone who sees the infamous backyard photos can tell, it's a different sling mount.



Example 1: The Weapon

Mr. Eisenberg. We will get other evidence in the record at a subsequent time to show those were the prints of Oswald. Mr. Latona, you were saying that you had worked over that rifle by applying a gray powder to it. Did you develop any fingerprints?

Mr. Latona. I was not successful in developing any prints at all on the weapon. I also had one of the firearms examiners dismantle the weapon and I processed the complete weapon, all parts, everything else. And no latent prints of value were developed.

Mr. EISENBERG. Does that include the clip?

Mr. LATONA. That included the clip, that included the bolt, it included the underside of the barrel which is covered by the stock.

Mr. EISENBERG. Were cartridge cases furnished to you at that time?

Mr. LATONA. They were, which I processed, and from which I got no prints.

Mr. EISENBERG. Therefore, the net result of your work on Exhibit 139 was that you could not produce an identifiable print?

Mr. LATONA. That's correct.

When the 6.5 mm Mannlicher Carcano arrived at FBI headquarters that night, their expert Sebastian Latona could not find any prints of value on it—even though he completely broke down the rifle, brought in his own photographer, and tried every lighting angle possible.

Latona wrote the pamphlet on fingerprinting used by almost every police department in America.



Example 2: The Ammunition






There was no box of bullets found among Oswald's personal effects.

The FBI searched the city of Dallas to find where the Western Cartridge Company bullets could be purchased.

They found two gun shops, and neither one recalled Oswald being there.



Example 3: The Alibi



Oswald was supposed to be in the sixth floor southeastern window.

He then left the rifle and 3 shells there and ran down the only bottom to top set of stairs in the Texas School Book Depository.

He was then allegedly seen on the second floor purchasing a beverage from a soda machine.







Big problem:

- From the fourth floor, 2 witnesses were on those stairs at the same time.
- Neither witness saw or heard Oswald.
- In 1999, we found out a third witness, Dorothy Garner, actually stayed in the 4th floor doorway until the police came up. She did not see anyone either.
- Although the Commission knew about Garner, she never testified. This is called concealing exculpatory evidence.



Example 4: The Autopsy







President Kennedy was killed by gunshot wounds.

The official story says he was struck both in the back and in the rear skull.

In a high profile case like this, the autopsy doctors usually <u>dissect</u> the wounds.

As criminalist Henry Lee told Oliver Stone and myself, this is really the only way to track trajectories through the body.

There was <u>no dissection at all</u> done on President Kennedy's corpse.

You must understand that in those circumstances, there were law enforcement officers, military people with various ranks, and you have to co-ordinate the operation according to directions. But you were one of the three qualified pathologists standing at that autopsy table, were you not, Doctor? Yes, I was Was this Army General a qualified pathologist?

At the trial of Clay Shaw in New Orleans in 1969 one of the pathologists, Pierre Finck, was asked this question.

He replied that they were directed not to do so by some of the high level military officers who were in the crowded gallery that night.


He could not recall who it was, but he said the man was not a doctor.

This was very important because most people do not think the back wound lines up with the anterior neck wound.





Example 4: The Autopsy



Since Kennedy was fatally wounded by a bullet through the skull, one would expect the brain to be sectioned so one can figure trajectory, and also the number of bullets.


The official autopsy says this was not done. Why?

"In the interest of preserving the specimen."

Preserve it for whom? The brain disappeared anyway.



The (Supposed) Brain

This piece of evidence presents a serious problem for the official story, for three reasons:

First, the pictures of the brain do not match up with what 11 witnesses saw.

- They all saw a brain missing a significant amount of its mass.
- Some say as much as a third. The pictures at the archives show pretty much an intact brain.

There is a longitudinal laceration of the right hemisphere which is para-a. ttal in position approximately 2.5 cm, to the right of the of the middine which extended to the right of the second to the right of the frontal lobe monteriorly to the tip of the frontal lobe anteriorly. The base of the laceration is situated approximately 4.5 cm, below the vertex in the white matter. There is considerable loss of cortical substance above the base of the laceration, particularly in the parietal lobs. The margins of this laceration are at all points jagged and irregular, with additional lacerations extending in varying distances from the main laceration. In addition, there is a laceration of the corpus callosum extending from the genu to the tail. Exposed in this latter laceration are the interiors of the right lateral and third When viewed from the vertex the left corebral hemisphere is intact. There is marked engorgement of meningeal blood vessels of the left temporal and frontal regions with considerable associated sub-arachnoid hemorrhage. The gyri and sulci over the left hemisphere are of essentially normal size and distribution. Those on the right are too fragmented and distorted for satisfactory description. When viewed from the basilar aspect the disruption of the right cortex is again obvious. There is a longitudinal laceration of the mid-brain through the floor of the third ventricle just behind the optic chiasm and the mammillary bodies. This laceration partially communicates with an oblique 1.5 cm. tear through the left cerebral peduncle. There are irregular superficial lacerations over the basilar aspects of the left temporal and frontal lobes. In the interest of preserving the specimen coronal sections are not made. The following sections are taken for a. From the margin of the laceration in the right parietal lobe. b. From the margin of the laceration in the corpus callosum. c. From the anterior portion of the laceration in the right frontal lobe. d. From the contused left fronto-parietal cortex. e. From the line of transection of the spinal cord. f. From the right cerebellar cortex. g. From the superficial laceration of the basilar aspect of the left temporal


Second, the official weight of the brain is 1500 grams.


- That is well above the average of about 1350 grams.
- How could this be with all the blood and tissue exploding in the Zapruder film, dripping in the back seat of the car and visible on Jackie Kennedy's clothes?

<u>Third</u>, the official autopsy photographer, John Stringer, testified under oath before the Review Board that he did not take the archival pictures of Kennedy's brain.


- He said he did not use that kind of film, and he did not use that kind of photographic process.
- Stringer was an instructor in autopsy photography and wrote a textbook on the subject.



Inadmissible Evidence







Medical witnesses were deposed for the ARRB by Jeremy Gunn & Doug Horne

In a court of law, Stringer's testimony would make the pictures inadmissible, and bring in the factor of prosecutorial fraud.

This, plus concealing exculpatory evidence could lead to having the case dismissed.



Inadmissible Evidence



There is more evidence that would have been thrown out of court.

For example: Commission Exhibit (CE) 399, known as the Magic Bullet.








As we show in JFK Revisited, the FBI lied about CE 399 three times:

- The FBI agent whom they said showed the bullet to the first witnesses to handle it—agent Bardwell Odum—later denied he ever did such a thing. Yet the Commission relied on this identification in their report.
- The agent who was supposed to have delivered the magic bullet to the FBI lab and initialed it, Elmer Lee Todd, did not initial the bullet. His initials are not on that bullet today.
- The man who he delivered it to, technician Robert Frazier, already had the magic bullet at 7:30 and marked it in his notes. How is that possible if Todd did not even get the bullet until 8:50 pm that night?

Josiah Thompson

Declassified FBI memo reporting neither Tomlinson nor Wright could identify "C1" [CE 399] as the bullet they handled on 11/22/63.



When author Josiah Thompson showed a picture of CE 399 to O. P. Wright, the man who turned over that bullet to the Secret Service on the day of the assassination, Wright said:

That is not the bullet I surrendered. This bullet has a rounded nose. I turned over a sharp-nosed bullet that looks like a hunting round.

Wright was very familiar with firearms. Prior to becoming chief of security at Parkland Hospital he worked in the sheriff's office in Dallas for a number of years.



Too few people know or understand that there were (at least) two prior plots to kill Kennedy in November of 1963.

- One took place in Chicago on November 2nd.
- One was aborted in Tampa on November 18th.



Prior Plots: Chicago 11/02/1963







An uncanny resemblance to what happened in Dallas.

- The assassination was to take place after the motorcade pulled off an exit ramp and passed a tall building.
- There was a hit team of four Cuban exiles equipped with high powered rifles.
- And the designated fall guy, <u>Thomas Vallee</u>, was, like Oswald, a former Marine who was stationed at a U-2 base in the Far East, and had been involved in training Cuban exiles.





Prior Plots: Tampa 11/18/1963







In Tampa, the fall guy was to be another Cuban exile: Gilberto Lopez.

- Like Oswald, Lopez had been a member of the <u>Fair Play for Cuba Committee</u> (FPCC).
- In Tampa the murder scene was to be the Floridian Hotel, a 23 story building Kennedy's motorcade was going to pass by.
- After Tampa, Lopez reportedly went to Texas, then to Mexico City, and from there was the only passenger on board a Cubana Airlines plane to Havana, in a flight paid for by the Fair Play for Cuba Committee.





Who was Lee Harvey Oswald?











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- An alleged Marxist who happens to want to join the Marine Corps.
- A radar operator who learns Russian while in the Marine Corps.
- A soldier who is granted one of the speediest hardship discharges in Marine Corps history while in California in order to help his mother back in Texas. Yet after being discharged, he only stayed in Texas for three days.



Oswald "defects" to the USSR






- He then sails for Europe. And he knows the one city in Europe that will grant visas into Russia in 72 hours: Helsinki, Finland.
- While he is in Helsinki, the impoverished Marine stayed at the two swankiest hotels in the city, equivalent to the Ritz Carlton.



How?


By rigging his file there so that his documents would only go to the Office of Security, bypassing normal procedure.

Oswald in the USSR






- In Moscow, the Russians smoke him out pretty easily and understand he is part of the false defector program, on a mission to collect intelligence.








- Understanding his failure, Oswald returns to the USA at a time when both the CIA and FBI have secret operations to counteract the <u>Fair Play for Cuba</u> <u>Committee</u> (FPCC).
- Oswald was the only member of the New Orleans branch, and was advised by New York headquarters not to open one in that Deep South city.
- He did anyway.

- On many of the flyers he handed out to support the FPCC he listed the committee's local address at <u>544 Camp</u> <u>Street</u>.
- This building housed both the CIAbacked Cuban Revolutionary Council and the office of the extreme rightwing activist Guy Banister.





Oswald, "Pro-Castro Communist"







- The evidence indicates that Oswald was a part of the CIA/FBI operation to discredit the Fair Play for Cuba Committee that summer.
- This is why he gets in a fight with a Cuban exile, is arrested, jailed, convicted and pays a fine. For receiving a punch?
- These films and pictures get blasted into the media on November 22nd and 23rd to brand Oswald a communist and supply a motive for killing JFK.















Three foreign policy examples

1. Vietnam


- At the time of JFK's death, there were no American combat troops in Vietnam.
- Three months after the Warren Commission volumes were issued, the first 3,500 landed at Da Nang.
- By the end of the year, President Johnson had 170,000 there.
- By 1968, there were 540,000.
- 58,000 Americans died in that conflict, 3.8 million Vietnamese, and as a result of Nixon's invasion of Cambodia, about 2 million perished there.











Three foreign policy examples


2. Indonesia

- In 1965, President Sukarno was overthrown.
- As a result of the military takeover that ensued, about 500,000 members of the PKI, the communist party, were killed.
- The USA backed this overthrow, which as our film shows, would not have happened under JFK.









Three foreign policy examples

3. Middle East

- Kennedy had insisted that Israel allow the atomic reactor at Dimona to be inspected, since he did not want nuclear weapons to spread in the Middle East.
- He had threatened to pull funding over this.
- After his death, President Johnson dropped this policy.
- Today, both Israel and the Muslim country of Pakistan have many, many atomic warheads.







In 1975, when the US left Saigon via helicopter, Secretary of State Henry Kissinger called an old friend and said: We should have never been there.

Kennedy knew that in 1961.

His attempt to extricate us was cut short, with disastrous results for everyone involved.
